Celtic Library Access policy

The Celtic Library at Jesus College supports study and research in the Celtic languages.

Admissions

It is open to all members of the University of Oxford specialising in Celtic, including:

- BA Modern Languages, BA EMEL, and joint courses with Modern Languages
- M.St., M.Phil., and D.Phil. Celtic Studies
- academic staff with Celtic interests

Members of Jesus College in these categories are automatically registered as readers.

<u>Members of Jesus College not in these categories</u> may apply to the College Librarian for temporary admission.

<u>Members of other colleges in these categories</u> will be registered on application to the College Librarian. A list of registered readers from other colleges is held at the Lodge.

<u>All other readers</u>, including those without membership of the University, may apply to the College Librarian for an appointment. Admission will be granted only to consult books and journals not available in the Bodleian Libraries.

Access

The Celtic Library is open 24 hours a day.

Registered readers from Jesus College can use their fob to enter the Celtic Library.

<u>Registered readers from other colleges</u> may borrow one of two keys to access the Celtic Library. The key is issued from the Lodge on production of the reader's University Card and must be returned to the Lodge on leaving College premises.

All other readers must arrange an appointment with the College Librarian.

Borrowing

<u>Registered readers</u>, including members of Jesus College granted temporary access, may borrow books and journals from the Celtic Library.

All other readers have access for reference only.
